An increased entry of ewes met a continued similar trade. Once again strength and meat were easiest sold. Suffolk's sold to the top price of £131.50, Continentals sold to £130, Mules to £110. Although another large number of small and plain ewes forward the overall average was 70.67. An entry of rams sold to an average of 104.50.

316 STORE CATTLE

Store cattle met a spectacular trade peaking at £1,605 – 300ppk. Steers met a blistering trade with a run of 18-month-old Aberdeen Angus from WH Cook topping at £1,605 with other lots from the same vendor selling to £1,590, £1,445 and £1,425. Continental steers saw a strong demand with 19-month-old Charolais x peaking at £1,330 and Lim x 17-month 500kg to £1,400 from BC & LS Bayliss. A fantastic entry of young steers from JR Smith & BJ Smith saw 11-month-old Lim x peak at £1,440 with other lots from the same vendor at £1,255 twice, £1,235, £1,160, £1,150, £1,130 and £1,120. The only way to describe the trade on weanling steers was blistering. Overall Steer average £1,100 – 240ppk.

An entry of 155 heifers peaked at 300ppk - £1,340. Strong heifers attracted fierce bidding selling to £1,320 for a run of Simmental x 520kg from A W Lewis. A British Blue x heifer from the same vendor peaked at £1,340. Pure bred South Devon heifers (20 months) sold to £1,200. A fantastic entry of Lim x heifers from Messrs Smith sold to £1,120, £1,100 twice with the main of the young well bred suckler heifers trading between 250 – 300ppk. Overall heifers averaged 235ppk, £967 per head.

A short entry of feeding bulls topped at £1,120 for Aberdeen Angus from BB Farming. A British Blue x cow with Simmental x steer calf topped at £1,750.
