An increased entry of lambs met another strong trade peaking at £149 – 267 ppk.

All classes of lambs met strong bidding, with flesh meat and weight being the order of the day. Well fleshed medium weight continentals consistently sold from 250 – 267 ppk.

Heavy weights again attracted great demand with 50kg + lambs selling from £130 - £149.

An increased entry of generally better quality ewes met a stronger demand. Strength and meat still the easiest sold. Continentals sold to £156.50. Suffolks to £141. Mules to £110. The overall average was an outstanding £92.89 an increase of £15 per head on the previous week. A short entry of rams sold to £136.

TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE – 45

An entry of 45 TB Restricted store cattle attracted a ring full of buyers seeing Hereford X Steers peak at £1,390 – 230 ppk.

Native bred Angus X Steers topped at £1,090 (15 – 17 months).

Heifers attracted as much demand as the steers peaking at £1,190 for Hereford X Heifers (18 months).

STORE CATTLE - 213

COWS AND CALVES

A bustling ring of buyers saw Cows and Calves peak at £2,000, steers to £1,250 and heifers to £1,140.

A fantastic entry of 17 Pedigree Hereford Cows with calves at foot. Genuine dispersal of Caesars Herefords saw cows with calves at foot peak at £2,000 for a pedigree Hereford Cow 3 year old with a pedigree heifer calf at foot, 7 months old.

Overall cows with calves at foot averaged £1,680.

STORE CATTLE

An entry of 84 steers saw pedigree beef Shorthorn steers (19 – 20 months) peak at £1,250 from Messrs A W Lawrence and Son.

Stronger farming steers were in short supply, however saw 14 month old Limousin X Steers sell to £1,040 from NR & SH Wellington. Larger British Blue X Friesian Steers (18 months) from Hopes Ash Farm realized £1,020 and Angus steers (13 months) selling to £960 from W H Cook.

Overall steers averaged £1,037 per head.

Heifers attracted strong interest peaking at £990 for an entry of Aberdeen Angus X Holstein heifers (18 months) from Messrs DB & RM Edwards. The entry of heifers was dominated by younger heifers however consistently seeing suckler bred sorts trading between 230 – 260 ppk.

Overall heifers averaged £887 per head.
