STORE CATTLE REPORT

Thursday 26TH January 2023

Store Cattle – 219

A nice entry of store cattle for the second sale in January met a spectacular trade peaking at £1480 – 296ppkg.

An entry of 122 Steers peaked at £1480 (twice) for Simmental x from EW, DA & NE Evans.

Native bred Aberdeen Angus from S K Batt topped at £1470 for 19 month old Steers with others from the same vendor reaching £1370 and £1340.

Young Continental Steers were on fire with Limousin x aged 16 months from J Jackson peaking at £1450 – 296ppkg.

Many other smart Continentals selling from 270p – 298ppkg.

Overall Steer average £1184 per head – 254ppkg.

A fantastic show of Heifers peaked at £1430 for a run of 20 month old Limousin x GA & RG Savage.

A run of British Blue x peaked at £1340 from A W Lewis.

Young grazing Heifers peaked at £1255 for a run of Charolais x from GD & MJ Samuel.

Generally better quality sorts of grazing Heifers sold from 260p – 281ppkg.

Overall Heifers averaged at £1067 per head – 240ppkg.
