STORE CATTLE REPORT

Thursday 27th April 2023

Store Cattle – 326 (Sale at 11:15am) Auctioneer: William Probert

A nice entry of 326 store cattle met a fast and furious trade from start to finish. Grazing stores met a phenomenal trade at 365ppkg.

An entry of 157 steers peaked at £1580 500kg from V A Harper & Son. Many other stronger steers sold from £1380 - £1580 consistently.

Grazing steers saw the dearest trade with a run of Charolais x from C S Francis topping at 365ppkg, followed by a run of Charolais averaging at an astonishing 340ppkg. Grazing steers consistently sold from 300 – 365ppkg.

Overall steers averaged £1097 – 263ppkg.

A fantastic entry of heifers met a blistering trade topping at £1950 per head for an entry of Limousin x from K J Perry, heifers from the same vendor sold to £1840 and £1700.

Grazing heifers met a blistering trade with Charolais x soaring to 365ppkg. Again, Continental grazing heifers were easily sold, selling from 300p – 365ppkg.

Overall heifers averaged £1023 per head 258ppkg.

More cattle could have easily been sold to this electric trade.
