A shorter entry of very commercial finished cattle continued to meet strong demand throughout the sale. steers topped at **£2,537 per head**, (372 ppk) for an entry from Messrs DM & CS Andrews.

cattle remained keenly sought after by retail buyers, with prices ranging from **330–372p/kg**.

There were few traditional butcher-type native heifers forward sold well at **340–360p/kg**.

More cattle could have been easily sold to this electric trade.

A larger entry of cull cows met fierce competition, with the sale largely comprising Grade 2 and 3 beef cows. The trade peaked at 296p/kg (£2,344 per head), with well-fleshed continental cows generally selling between 280 – 296p/kg.

Leaner types realised 250–270p/kg.

More cows are required to meet demand from the buying contingent.

A nice entry of finished hogs met a flying trade, peaking at 420p/kg (£170 per head).

A strong contingent of quality export lambs sold very freely between 380–420p/kg, meeting keen competition from buyers. Quality exports weighing 38–43kg realised £170–£180 per head.

Demand for heavyweight lambs remained consistent, seeing a lift. Generally, hogs 48kg+ sold from £170–£191 per head.

Trade remained consistent throughout the sale, with lambs achieving an overall **SQQ of 400ppk**.

More lambs could have been easily sold to satisfy buyer demand.

A good entry of cull ewes met strong demand throughout for both weight and meat, topping at **£214 per head**. Well-fleshed, stronger ewes regularly sold between **£170–£200**, while a large entry of NC Mule ewes realised **£150–£170 per head**

Leaner and smaller-framed ewes were equally well bid for, selling from **£130–£150**.

A short entry of tups sold to **£150 per head**.

Overall, the ewe trade averaged an unbelievable **£172 per head**, with further numbers easily absorbed by buyers.
