Store cattle met another fast trade despite the depression of the current fat cattle trade. Steers peaked at £975 for a run of South Devon from Mesr H Chapman & Son with cattle from the same vendor also selling to £935 and £900. Continental cross long term steers commanded the greatest interest consistently selling from 180 – 200ppk. Steers overall average £845 per head.

The entry was dominated by heifers with 18 month Charolais peaking at £905 from Mesr BC & LS Bayliss. Heifers 400kg plus commanded the strongest demand with premiums paid for well conformed continental crosses. Overall heifers averaged £721 per head.

Calves met a resistant trade, however Aberdeen Angus bulls sold to £130, Blonde D'Aquitaine cross to £130 and Simmental cross heifers to £145 on two occasions.
